1. What is GIISMUN Tokyo Chapter 4?

Delegates are highly recommended to submit a position paper as it allows them to understand and research upon their respective countries and agendas in depth.

10. How are resolutions drafted and passed at GIISMUN Tokyo Chapter 4?

Details regarding the format, drafting and passing of resolution papers are specified in the Delegate Handbook and delegates are requested to go through the handbook thoroughly especially if it is their first time attending GIISMUN Tokyo.
